WITNESS THAT:

WHEREAS, the League of Women Voters of Indianapolis is a nonpartisan political organization that encourages informed and active participation in government and also influences public policy through education and advocacy; and,

WHEREAS, the League of Women Voters of Indianapolis supports the need for a regional transportation network that includes rail transit, bus rapid transit, bus, express bus, bike and pedestrian paths, and road and highway improvements; and,

WHEREAS, the regional transportation network will support and compliment energy-efficient and environmentally sound regional transportation planning that improves the well-being of Indianapolis-Marion County residents and affords better access to housing and jobs,

IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED by the League of Women Voters of Indianapolis as follows:

The League of Women Voters of Indianapolis supports the enactment of enabling legislation that authorizes voter referendums to enact funding measures that create dedicated and adequate funding for the design, construction, financing, operation and maintenance of transit.
